SAFETY RULES FOR MACHINES

1.BAND SAW MACHINE:

- 1. Saw curves gradually. Sudden twists may break the blade.
- 2. Always adjust the blade guard and top guides as close as possible to the workpiece.
- 3. Should a blade break or slip from the band wheels while you are using the saw, switch off immediately and stand back. Do not open the blade-access doors until the machine has come to a stop.

2. TABLE SAW MACHINE:

- 1. Use a push stick to feed a workpiece rather than risk touching a cutter
- 2. Don't use this machine without the splitter

3.SURFACE PLANER:

- 1. Never use THIS planer without a properly adjusted guard in position
- 2. Don't attempt to surface plane a workpiece that is too short to be held firmly in both hands
- 3. Pass the work from infeed to outfeed table

4.THICKNESSER:

- 1. The thickness of the lumber should be examined before you plane it.
- 2. Before starting the machine, lower the table and remove any wood shavings, loose knots and slivers of wood from the table and roller assembly.
- 3. Never put your hands into a thicknesser to retrieve a workpiece or clear away shavings.

5.MOULDER:

- 1. Remove large amounts of waste by making two or more passes.
- 2. Always keep your router cutters sharp.
